ALI – part of the industry-leading Access Enterprise Forms Management (EFM) suite – is a tablet-based documentation solution that enables physicians and nurses to access and complete clinical documentation from anywhere in the facility. A clinician simply selects the patient, chooses the form type – such as progress note, questionnaire and H&P – and completes it using the tablet's stylus. Upon completion, the data is automatically interfaced into the patient's EHR via the content/document management system, and is immediately available across the hospital. ALI helps physicians easily transition to hybrid and electronic records by maintaining the speed, flexibility and simplicity of paper while removing its physical limitations.

- Speed care delivery and patient service by accessing and completing progress notes, H&Ps and other clinical documents on the fly

- Improve service to patients who speak another language with multi-lingual forms

- Automatically index completed forms with patients' EHRs, with no user effort

- Improve data mobility, accuracy, availability and security

- Validate data at the point of collection to minimize errors and ensure all required information is obtained

- Automatically pull in previous data for a patient (e.g. incorporate yesterday's progress note for today's version)

- Speed form completion with checkboxes, drop-downs and the ability to complete multiple areas with a single piece of information

- Get even the least tech-savvy users up and running quickly with a familiar pen input interface

- Add annotated diagrams, digital photos and signatures directly to clinical forms

## Access Logical Ink in Action for Clinical Documentation

Access Logical Ink can make almost any clinical and patient registration process more mobile, efficient and collaborative. In this example, you'll see how it simplifies the completion of a progress note.

- 1) A physician searches for a patient by MRN, account, last name or scans the patient's wristband.
- 2) She selects the patient and form to be completed - a progress note
- 3) If a previous note has been completed it will prefill with data for editing. Additional data can also be loaded, such as vitals and lab results.
- 4) The physician updates the plan and impression, completes the progress note, signs and submits it
- 5) The physician completes the questionnaire, annotates the knee diagrams, signs and submits it
- 6) An image is automatically generated and passed to the patients EHR for immediate availability via the content/document management system
